The Public Processions (Northern Ireland)  
Act 1998 (Accounts and Audit) Order 2000

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 16(4) and paragraph 12(6) of Schedule 1 of the Public Processions (Northern Ireland) Act 1998(1), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Processions (Northern Ireland) Act 1998 (Accounts and Audit) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 30th March 2000.

**Accounts and audit**

2. In paragraph 12(5) of Schedule 1 to the Public Processions (Northern Ireland) Act 1998 for the words “31st December”, where they first appear, substitute the words “31st March”.
