Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Processions (Northern Ireland) Act 1998 (Accounts and Audit) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 30th March 2000.

2. In paragraph 12(5) of Schedule 1 to the Public Processions (Northern Ireland) Act 1998 for the words "31st December", where they first appear, substitute the words "31st March".
