**The Social Security (Contributions) Regulations 2001**

**[<sup>F1</sup>PART 7A**

**Electronic Communications**

**[<sup>F1</sup>Standards of accuracy and completeness**

**90O.**—(1) [<sup>F2</sup>Any paragraph 22 return] delivered by a method of electronic communications must meet the standards of accuracy or completeness set by specific or general directions given by the Board.

(2) [<sup>F2</sup>Any paragraph 22 return] which fails to meet those standards must be treated as not having been delivered.]
