The Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-And-Mouth Disease) (No. 4) Regulations 2001

Exemptions

- 11.** The prohibitions in regulations 5, 6, 7 and 10 shall not apply in relation to—
- (a) products produced and packaged outside the United Kingdom if the packaging indicates the country of origin and they remain in their original packaging; or
 - (b) products which are—
 - (i) produced in an establishment approved by the Minister (or in Northern Ireland the Department of Agriculture and Rural Development) from pre-processed products originating outside the United Kingdom which, since introduction into the United Kingdom have been transported, stored and processed separately from products not destined for export; and
 - (ii) accompanied by a commercial document or official certificate as required by these Regulations.
