**The Social Security Commissioners
(Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations 2001**

Made - - - - 20th March 2001

Coming into force - - 2nd July 2001

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraphs 8 to 10, 19, 20(1) and (3) and 23(1) and (2) of Schedule 7 to the Child Support, Pensions and Social Security Act 2000^{M1}, sections 14 to 16, 28, 79(2), (4) and (6) and 84 of, and Schedules 4 and 5 to, the Social Security Act 1998^{M2}, section 4(2) of the Forfeiture Act 1982^{M3}, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the Scottish Ministers, in accordance with section 79(2)^{M4} of the Social Security Act 1998 and paragraph 20(1) of Schedule 7 to the Child Support, Pensions and Social Security Act 2000, and with the Council on Tribunals in accordance with section 8 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1992^{M5}, makes the following Regulations, a draft of which has, in accordance with section 80(1) of the Social Security Act 1998, been laid before and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:
