The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 30(1), (2)(a), (b), (c) and (d) and (2A) and 41(4) of the Employment Tribunals Act 1996^(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after consultation with the Lord President of the Court of Session, hereby makes the following Rules:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Employment Appeal Tribunal (Amendment) Rules 2001 (Amendment) Rules 2001 and shall come into force on 16th April 2001.

Amendment of the Employment Appeal Tribunal (Amendment) Rules 2001

2. Rule 1(1) of the Employment Appeal Tribunal (Amendment) Rules 2001^(b) shall be amended by the substitution of the words “16th July 2001” for the words “18th April 2001”.
