**The Retained Organs Commission
(Establishment and Constitution)
Amendment Order 2001**

Made - - - - - *9th May 2001*
Laid before Parliament *10th May 2001*
Coming into force - - *31st May 2001*

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11(4) and 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and extent

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Retained Organs Commission (Establishment and Constitution) Amendment Order 2001 and shall come into force on 31st May 2001.

(2) This Order extends to England only.

Amendment of the Retained Organs Commission (Establishment and Constitution) Order 2001

2. In article 4 of the Retained Organs Commission (Establishment and Constitution) Order 2001 (constitution of the Commission)(b), in paragraph (b), for “7” substitute “9”.
