# Title, commencement and extent

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Protection Products (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2001, extend to England and Wales, and come into force on 1st August 2001.

## **Amendment of the Plant Protection Products Regulations 1995**

**2.** In so far as they extend to England and Wales, the Plant Protection Products Regulations 1995  $^{M3}$  shall be amended by substituting for the definition of "the Directive" in regulation 2(1), the following definition—
