**The European Communities (Designation) (No. 2)  
Order 2001**

*Made - - - - - 18th July 2001*

*Laid before Parliament 30th July 2001*

*Coming into force - - 20th August 2001*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, The 18th day of July 2001

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(a)</sup> and section 29(1) of the Government of Wales Act 1998<sup>(b)</sup>, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the European Communities (Designation) (No. 2) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 20th August 2001.

(2) In this Order—

“the Act” means the European Communities Act 1972, and

“regulations” means regulations made pursuant to section 2(2) of the Act.

**Designation of Ministers**

2. For the purposes of section 2(2) of the Act, the Ministers specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this Order are designated in relation to the matters specified in column (2) of that Schedule.

**Designation of the National Assembly for Wales**

3.—(1) For the purposes of section 2(2) of the Act, the National Assembly for Wales is designated in relation to the matters specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

(2) Regulations made by the National Assembly for Wales shall apply in relation to Wales only.

(3) Where the National Assembly for Wales is designated by this Order in relation to any matter, for which any Minister or government department has been designated by this or any other Order for the purposes of section 2(2) of the Act, any of them may make regulations and, if regulations are made by more than one, they may do so jointly.

**Revocation of earlier designation**

4. The designation of the Secretary of State in relation to measures relating to energy efficiency and performance requirements for household products in the European Communities (Designation) (No. 3) Order 1996(a) is hereby revoked.

Article 2

### DESIGNATION OF MINISTERS

(1) <i>Ministers</i>	(2) <i>Matters in relation to which Ministers are designated</i>
The Secretary of State	Cableway installations designed to carry people and components of such installations
The Secretary of State	Information society services
The Secretary of State	Energy efficiency and performance requirements for products.

## SCHEDULE 2

Article 2

### DESIGNATION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY FOR WALES

1. Measures relating to the requirement for an assessment of the impact on the environment of projects likely to have significant effects on the environment in so far as they concern the use of uncultivated land or semi-natural areas for intensive agricultural purposes.
2. The protection of waters against pollution caused by nitrates from agricultural sources.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This is a further Order in the series designating authorities which may exercise the power to make regulations conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 and specifying the matters in relation to which that power may be exercised. This Order also revokes a designation in the European Communities (Designation) (No. 3) 1996 Order(a) relating to energy efficiency and performance requirements for household products.
