SCHEDULE 3

PART I

FURTHER INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS TO ACCOMPANY AN APPLICATION IN RESPECT OF A GAS SUPPLIER LICENCE(1)

- 1. A gas supplier licence may authorise the holder to supply gas—
 - (a) to any premises;
 - (b) only to premises specified in the licence, or to premises of a description so specified; or
 - (c) only to any premises situated in a specified area, or to premises of a specified description which are so situated.

(see section 7A(1) of the Act)

Provide a sufficient description adequately specifying(2) the premises or a description of the premises and the location of the premises intended to be supplied, and, in the case of an application that relates to (c) above, also the specified area.
