**The Social Fund Cold Weather Payments (General)
Amendment Regulations 2001**

Made - - - - - *9th October 2001*
Laid before Parliament *11th October 2001*
Coming into force - - *1st November 2001*

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 138(2) and (4) and 175(1), (3) and (4) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after agreement by the Social Security Advisory Committee that proposals in respect of these Regulations should not be referred to it(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Fund Cold Weather Payments (General) Amendment Regulations 2001 and shall come into force on 1st November 2001.

Amendment of Schedule 1 to the Social Fund Cold Weather Payments (General) Regulations 1988

2.—(1) Schedule 1 to the Social Fund Cold Weather Payments (General) Regulations 1988(c) (identification of stations and postcode districts) shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of this regulation.

(2) For entries 6, 11, 13, 20, 29 and 70 there shall be respectively substituted the entries in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(3) The new entry 16A (Cassley) specified in the Schedule to these Regulations shall be inserted after entry 16 (Carlisle).
