**The Representation of the People  
(England and Wales) Regulations 2001**

**PART III**

**REGISTRATION**

*Information about electors*

**Power to require information**

**23.**—(1) A registration officer may require any person to give information required for the purposes of that officer's duties in maintaining registers of parliamentary and local government electors.

(2) A registration officer is under a duty to require persons to give information required for the purposes of that officer's duty under section 3(1) of the Juries Act 1974<sup>(1)</sup>.

(3) If any person—

(a) fails to comply with <sup>F1</sup>...

<sup>F1</sup>(b) .....

any such requisition of the registration officer as is mentioned in this regulation, he shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
