## INTERNATIONAL IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES

The European Communities (Immunities and Privileges of the North Atlantic Salmon Conservation Organization) Order 2001

Coming into force - - 15th November 2001

At the Court at Buckingham Palace the 14th day of November 2001

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been laid before Parliament and has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament;

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(a) or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the European Communities (Immunities and Privileges of the North Atlantic Salmon Conservation Organization) Order 2001. It shall come into force on the day after the day on which it was made.
- 2. The European Communities (Immunities and Privileges of the North Atlantic Salmon Conservation Organization) Order 1985(b) shall be amended as follows—
  - (1) After Article 6(3) there shall be inserted the following new paragraph:—
    - "(4) The Organization shall be accorded a refund of insurance premium tax and air passenger duty paid by the Organization in the exercise of its official activities."
