The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 126(4) of and Schedule 9A to the National Health Service Act 1977⁽¹⁾ and after consultation with the Council on Tribunals in accordance with section 8 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1992⁽²⁾ hereby makes the following Rules:
