At the Council Chamber, Whitehall, the 30th day of November 2001 By the Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council

Whereas in pursuance of section 11 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966(a) the Council of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons has made the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners Registration (Amendment) Regulations 2001 as set out in the Schedule to this Order:—

And whereas by section 25(1) of the said Act such Regulations shall not have effect unless approved by the Privy Council:

Now, therefore, Their Lordships, having taken the said Regulations into consideration, are hereby pleased, in exercise of the power conferred by section 25(1) of the said Act, to order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations Order of Council 2001, and shall come into force on 1st April 2002.
 - 2. The Regulations set out in the Schedule hereto are approved.
- 3. The Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations Order of Council 2000(b) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

THE VETERINARY SURGEONS AND VETERINARY PRACTITIONERS REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2001

The Council of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons in exercise of its powers under section 11 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966, hereby make the following Regulations.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners Registration (Amendment) Regulations 2001.
- 2. The Schedule (Table of Fees Payable) to the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners Registration (Amendment) Regulations 2000(a) shall be replaced by the following:—

The Regulations approved by this Order further amend the Veterinary Surgeons and Veterinary Practitioners Registration Regulations by increasing, with effect from 1st April 2002, the fees payable for the registration and annual retention of names on the Registers of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons. The fee increases range from 4 per cent to 10 per cent.
