The Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Order 2001

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this Order—

“the Act” means the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act 1982;

[^{F1}“the 2005 Agreement” means the Agreement made on 19th October 2005 between the European Community and the Kingdom of Denmark on jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in civil and commercial matters;]

[^{F2}“the Regulation” means Council Regulation (EC) No. 44/2001 of 22nd December 2000 on jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in civil and commercial matters, as amended from time to time and as applied by the 2005 Agreement;]

[^{F3}“Regulation State” in any provision, in the application of that provision in relation to the Regulation, means a Member State.]

(2) In Schedule 2 to this Order, a section, Part, Schedule or paragraph referred to by number alone is a reference to the section, Part, Schedule or paragraph so numbered in the Act.
