45.6 The table in this rule (Table 4) shows the amount to be allowed in respect of solicitors' costs in the circumstances mentioned. The amounts shown in Table 3 are to be allowed in addition, if applicable.

FIXED ENFORCEMENT COSTS

<p>For an application under rule 70.5(4) that an award may be enforced as if payable under a court order, where the amount outstanding under the award:</p>	
exceeds £25 but does not exceed £250	£30.75
exceeds £250 but does not exceed £600	£41.00
exceeds £600 but does not exceed £2,000	£69.50
exceeds £2,000	£75.50
<p>On attendance to question a judgment debtor (or officer of a company or other corporation) who has been ordered to attend court under rule 71.2 where the questioning takes place before a court officer, including attendance by a responsible representative of the solicitor:</p>	<p>for each half-hour or part, £15.00</p> <p>(When the questioning takes place before a judge, he may summarily assess any costs allowed.)</p>
<p>On the making of a final third party debt order under rule 72.8(6)(a) or an order for the payment to the judgment creditor of money in court under rule 72.10(1)(b):</p>	
if the amount recovered is less than £150	one-half of the amount recovered
otherwise	£98.50
