The Rail Vehicle Accessibility (South West Trains Class 458 Vehicles) Exemption Order 2001

- **5.**—(1) The exemption given by article 4(2) above in relation to regulation 5(1)(b) shall only apply while—
 - (a) the maximum amount of force required to operate a door control does not exceed 40 newtons; and
 - (b) the operator provides in that vehicle or, where an exempted vehicle forms part of a train, in that train a person, other than the driver of that vehicle or train, who is reasonably available to assist a disabled person.
- (2) The exemption given by article 4(2) above in relation to regulation 20(1)(f) is given on the condition that, until a handrail compliant with regulation 20(1)(f) is installed, no other hinged handrail is installed to the side of the toilet in the nearest toilet cubicle to a wheelchair space.
