Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(a) is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the European Communities (Designation) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 16th April 2001.

Designation of Department

2. For the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972, the Department specified in column (1) of the Schedule to this Order is designated in relation to the matters specified in column (2) of that Schedule.
