The Financial Assistance for Environmental Purposes (No. 2) Order 2002

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by section 153(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990(a), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Financial Assistance for Environmental Purposes (No. 2) Order 2002 and shall come into force on 27th August 2002.

Variation of section 153(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990

2. In section 153(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990(b) (purposes for which financial assistance may be given), after paragraph (pp) there shall be inserted—

"(qq) the fund known as the Aggregates Levy Sustainability Fund;".
