The Criminal Justice Act 1988 (Designated Countries and Territories) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2002

Made - - - - - *20th November 2002*

Laid before Parliament *2nd December 2002*

Coming into force - - *23rd December 2002*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 20th day of November 2002

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 96 of the Criminal Justice Act 1988^(a) is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice Act 1988 (Designated Countries and Territories) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2002, and shall come into force on 23rd December 2002.

(2) This Order extends to England and Wales only.

2. There shall be inserted in Schedule 1 to the Criminal Justice Act 1988 (Designated Countries and Territories) Order 1991^(b) (designation of countries and territories for the purposes of sections 96 and 97 of the Criminal Justice Act 1988), at the appropriate places in alphabetical order, the entries for the countries specified in the Schedule to this Order.
