The A45 Trunk Road (A45/A46 Stonebridge Highway Island, Coventry to the A45/A452 Stonebridge Island) (Detrunking) Order 2003

Made - - - - *28th April 2003*
Coming into force - - *19th May 2003*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980(1) and now vested in him(2), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf:

1. This Order may be cited as The A45 Trunk Road (A45/A46 Stonebridge Highway Island, Coventry to the A45/A452 Stonebridge Island) (Detrunking) Order 2003 and shall come into force on 19th May 2003.

3. The length of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road from the date on which the Order comes into force.

THE SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF THE TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

The length of Trunk Road ceasing to be trunk road is:

From a point on the western boundary of the A45/A46 Stonebridge Highway Island, Coventry (but not including the circulatory carriageway), (marked “A” on the plan), and continuing in a westerly direction through the City of Coventry and Districts of Solihull and North Warwickshire in the West Midlands and County of Warwickshire, terminating at a point on the eastern boundary of the A45/A452 Stonebridge Island, (but not including the circulatory carriageway) (marked “B” on the plan), a distance of approximately 15.6 kilometres.

It is shown by broad black dashes on the plan.
