# New Schools (General) (England) Regulations 2003

#### PART 6

### General Conduct of New Schools

### Minutes and papers

- **45.**—(1) The clerk (or the person appointed to act as clerk for the purpose of the meeting in accordance with regulation 39(5)) shall ensure that minutes of the proceedings of a meeting of the governing body are drawn up and signed (subject to the approval of the temporary governing body) by the chair of the next meeting.
- (2) Subject to paragraph (3), the temporary governing body shall, as soon as reasonably practicable, make available for inspection by any interested person, a copy of
  - (a) the agenda for every meeting;
  - (b) the signed minutes of every such meeting; and
- (3) The temporary governing body may exclude from any item required to be made available in pursuance of paragraph (2) any material relating to—
  - (a) a named person who works, or who it is proposed should work, at the new school;
  - (b) a named pupil at, or candidate for admission to, the new school;
  - (c) any other matter that, by reason of its nature, the temporary governing body is satisfied should remain confidential.
