# PESTICIDES, ENGLAND AND WALES

## The Plant Protection Products (Amendment) Regulations 2003

Made	15th July 2003
Laid before Parliament	16th July 2003
Coming into force	5th August 2003

The Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs and the National Assembly for Wales, being designated(a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(b) in relation to the common agriculture policy of the European Community, acting jointly (the National Assembly for Wales acting in relation to Wales only), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by that section, make the following Regulations:

#### Title, commencement and extent

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Protection Products (Amendment) Regulations 2003, extend to England and Wales, and come into force on 5th August 2003.

#### Amendment to the Plant Protection Products Regulations 1995

**2.**—(1) In so far as they extend to England and Wales, the Plant Protection Products Regulations 1995(c) shall be amended in accordance with paragraph (2) of this regulation.

(2) For Schedule AA1 (Instruments amending Council Directive 1991/414/EEC) there shall be substituted the provisions in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Schedule AA1, which sets out the instruments that amend Council Directive 1991/414/EEC, is replaced by the Schedule to these Regulations, which adds the substance added by Commission Directive 2003/5/EC (OJ No. L8, 14.1.2003, p. 7).
