The Education Act 2002 (Modification and

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Secretary of State by section 499(6) and (7) of the Education Act 1996⁽¹⁾, and section 214 of the Education Act 2002⁽²⁾, the Secretary of State for Education and Skills hereby makes the following Regulations:
