**The A259 Trunk Road, (Brenzett to M20 Junction 13,  
Folkestone) (Detrunking) Order 2003**

*Made* - - - - - *12th September 2003*

*Coming into force* - - - *30th September 2003*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980<sup>(a)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(b)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf:—

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road, (Brenzett to M20 Junction 13, Folkestone) (Detrunking) Order 2003 and shall come into force on 30th September 2003.

2. In this Order—

- (i) “principal road” as a classification for a highway, means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of enactments and instruments which refer to highways classified as principal roads and is also classified for the purpose of every other enactment and instrument which refers to highways classified by the Secretary of State; and
- (ii) “the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road between Brenzett and the M20 at Junction 13, Folkestone.

3. The length of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies Kent County Council that they are to be the highway authority for that length of road within their county boundary.

### LENGTH OF THE TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD
