# The Disability Discrimination Act 1995 (Private Hire Vehicles) (Carriage of Guide Dogs etc.) (England and Wales) Regulations 2003

### Citation, commencement, interpretation and extent

**1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 (Private Hire Vehicles) (Carriage of Guide Dogs etc.) (England and Wales) Regulations 2003 and shall come into force as follows—

- (a) regulation 2(1) on 31st December 2003; and
- (b) all other provisions on 31st March 2004.
- (2) In these Regulations "the Act" means the [<sup>F1</sup>Equality Act 2010].
- (3) These Regulations apply to England and Wales.

## Notices of exemption

**2.**—(1) The prescribed notice of exemption for the purposes of [ $^{F2}$ section 171(4)(b) of the Act] shall be a notice duly completed in accordance with the certificate of exemption, which shall be—

- (a) in the case of a driver of a private hire vehicle to whom the [<sup>F3</sup>exemption certificate] has been issued by a licensing authority in England, the notice set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations; and
- (b) in the case of a driver of a private hire vehicle to whom the [<sup>F4</sup>exemption certificate] has been issued by a licensing authority in Wales, the notice set out in Schedule 2 to these Regulations.

[<sup>F5</sup>(2) The prescribed manner of exhibiting a notice of exemption for the purposes of [<sup>F6</sup>section 171(4)(b) of the Act] shall be—

- (a) by displaying it—
  - (i) on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen of the private hire vehicle facing outwards; and
  - (ii) in a manner that readily permits its removal;
- (b) so that—

(i) its front is clearly visible from the outside of the private hire vehicle; and(ii) its back is clearly visible from the driver's seat of the private hire vehicle.]
