THIRD PARTIES

Payment to partner as alternative payee

- **34.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), where a [FI person with a partner] is entitled to child benefit or guardian's allowance, the Board may make arrangements whereby that benefit or allowance, as well as being payable to the person entitled to it, may, in the alternative, be paid to that person's partner on behalf of that person.
- (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to guardian's allowance where a [F2woman] has elected that the allowance is not to be paid to her husband [F3 or male civil partner] in accordance with regulation 10 of the Guardian's Allowance (General) Regulations 2003 (prescribed manner of making an election under section 77(9) of the Contributions and Benefits Act and section 77(9) of the Contributions and Benefits (NI) Act)(1).
