CLAIMS AND AWARDS

Withdrawing claims

9.—^[F1](1) A person who has made a claim for child benefit or guardian's allowance may withdraw it by giving notice—

- (a) in writing to the Board,
- (b) by telephone to the Board, or
- (c) in such other manner as the Board may accept as sufficient in the circumstances of the particular case.]

(2) A notice of withdrawal given in accordance with paragraph ^[F2](1)(a) has effect when it is received by an appropriate office.
