PART 8

UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT

Issue of uniform and equipment

45. The Secretary of State shall determine the circumstances in which and the conditions subject to which uniform and equipment is to be issued by the [^{F1}local policing body] to a member of a police force of the rank of constable or sergeant, and in making such a determination the Secretary of State may confer on the [^{F1}local policing body] discretion—

- (a) to specify the type of uniform and equipment to be issued;
- (b) to issue uniform and equipment to members of the police force in ranks other than constable or sergeant.
