The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 6(4) of the Access to Justice Act 1999(1), having had regard to the matters specified in section 25(3) and having consulted the General Council of the Bar and the Law Society, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Community Legal Service (Funding) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2003 and shall come into force on 15th April 2003.

**3.**—(1) At the end of article 5(1)(d), omit "or".

(2) After article 5(1)(e) insert—

"; or

(f) as part of the fast track asylum decision and appeals process pilot".
