(No.2) (Amendment) Regulations 2004**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Lord Chancellor by sections 12(2)(g), 13(1), 15(2)(d) and 22(1) of the Access to Justice Act 1999<sup>(1)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(2)</sup>, makes the following Regulations:
