The Government Resources and Accounts  
Act 2000 (Summarised Accounts of  
Special Health Authorities) Order 2004

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Government Resources and Accounts Act 2000 (Summarised Accounts of Special Health Authorities) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 14th June 2004.

**Summarised Accounts of Special Health Authorities**

2. Section 98(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> (requirement to prepare summarised accounts) shall not apply in relation to the Special Health Authorities<sup>(2)</sup> listed in the Schedule for a financial year ending on 31st March 2004, 31st March 2005, or 31st March 2006.
