**2004 No. 1708**

**The Social Security (Students and Income-related Benefits) Amendment Regulations 2004**

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Students and Income-related Benefits) Amendment Regulations 2004 and shall come into force—

- (a) for the purposes of this regulation, on 1st August 2004; and
- (b) for the purposes of regulations 2 to 7—
  - (i) in the case of a person whose period of study begins on or after 1st August 2004 but before 1st September 2004, on the day the period of study begins; and
  - (ii) in any other case, on 1st September 2004.

(2) In these Regulations—

“the Council Tax Benefit Regulations” means the Council Tax Benefit (General) Regulations 1992 <sup>M1</sup>;

“the Housing Benefit Regulations” means the Housing Benefit (General) Regulations 1987 <sup>M2</sup>;

“the Income Support Regulations” means the Income Support (General) Regulations 1987 <sup>M3</sup>;

“the Jobseeker’s Allowance Regulations” means the Jobseeker’s Allowance Regulations 1996 <sup>M4</sup>;

“period of study” for the purposes of paragraph (1) has the same meaning as in regulation 61 of the Income Support Regulations.
