**The Magistrates' Courts Warrants (Specification of Provisions)
(Amendment) Order 2004**

The Lord Chancellor and the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 125A(3) of the Magistrates' Court Act 1980(a), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts Warrants (Specification of Provisions) (Amendment) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 1st September 2004.

Amendment of the Magistrates' Courts Warrants (Specification of Provisions) Order 2000

2.—(1) The Magistrates' Courts Warrants (Specification of Provisions) Order 2000(b) shall be amended as follows.

(2) For paragraphs(a) and (b) in article 2 there shall be substituted the following paragraphs—

“(a) paragraph 7(2) of Schedule 7 to the Powers of Criminal Courts (Sentencing) Act 2000(c);

(aa) section 7(1) of the Bail Act 1976(d);

(b) in the Magistrates' Court Act 1980—

(i) section 1;

(ii) section 13;

(iii) section 76;

(iv) section 83(1) and (2);

(v) section 86(4);

(vi) section 93(5);

(vii) section 97;

(viii) section 97A(e);

(3) For paragraph (d) in article 2 there shall be substituted the following paragraph—

“(d) paragraph 4 of Schedule 3 to the Crime and Disorder Act 1998(a)”.

Sections 125A to 125D of the Magistrates' Courts Act 1980, as inserted by sections 92, 93, 94 and 96 of the Access to Justice Act 1999, make provision for the manner of enforcement of warrants under statutory provisions to be specified by order. This Order amends the Magistrates' Court Warrants (Specification of Provisions) Order 2000 which specified provisions.
