**2004 No. 2040**

**The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Scallops) (Irish Sea) Order 2004**

**Prohibitions applicable throughout the United Kingdom**

6. No person shall in the United Kingdom or United Kingdom waters —
- (a) use any scallops taken from the designated area after the relevant time in the preparation or processing for supply to purchasers or others of food or anything from which food could be derived;
  - (b) land any scallops taken from waters in the designated area after the relevant time;
  - (c) supply, or possess for supply, any scallops which were in the designated area after the relevant time;
  - (d) feed to any creature any feeding stuff prepared or processed from scallops taken from the designated area after the relevant time; or
  - (e) supply, or possess for supply, to purchasers or others any food or anything from which food could be derived in the preparation or processing of which any scallops that were taken from the designated area after the relevant time were used.
