# The Race Relations Act 1976 (General Statutory Duty) Order 2004

### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Race Relations Act 1976 (General Statutory Duty) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 31st December 2004.

### Amendment of Schedule 1A to the Race Relations Act 1976

- 2. Schedule 1A to the Race Relations Act 1976(1) is amended as follows:
  - (a) in Part II-
    - (i) under the sub-heading "Libraries, museums and arts", at the end of the entry relating to The Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission for England insert "(Known as English Heritage)"; omit the entry relating to Resource: The Council for Museums, Archives and Libraries and after the entry relating to The Millennium Commission insert "The Museum, Archives and Libraries Council"; and omit the entry relating to the Science Museum;
    - (ii) under the sub-heading "Regulatory, audit and inspection", at the end of the entry relating to The Engineering Council insert "(UK)"; and
    - (iii) under the sub-heading "Other Bodies, etc", at the end of the entry relating to The Gas and Electricity Consumer Council insert "(Energywatch)";
  - (b) in Part III under the sub-heading "Education", for the entry relating to The National College of School Leadership substitute "The National College for School Leadership"; and
  - (c) after Part III insert the headings and entries set out in the Schedule to this Order.
