
EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into force on 1st January 2005 the provisions of section 35(a) of the Waste and Emissions Trading Act 2003 (“the Act”) in relation to England.

Part 1 of the Act makes provision, among other things, for waste management in England and for miscellaneous and supplementary matters.

Section 35(a) repeals section 49 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 (c. 43) (collection authorities' waste recycling plans).

A full regulatory impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as it has no impact on the costs of business.

Changes to legislation:

There are currently no known outstanding effects for the The Waste and Emissions Trading Act 2003 (Commencement No. 2) (England) Order 2004.
