

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

^{M1}These Regulations make provision as to the drugs, medicines or other substances that may be ordered for patients in the provision of medical services under a general medical services contract within the meaning of section 28Q of the National Health Service Act 1977 .

Regulation 2 and Schedule 1 list the drugs, medicines and other substances that may not be ordered under such a contract.

Regulation 3 and Schedule 2 specify the drugs, medicines and other substances that may be ordered under such a contract only in certain circumstances and sets out those circumstances.

Changes to legislation:

There are currently no known outstanding effects for the National Health Service (General Medical Services Contracts) (Prescription of Drugs etc.) Regulations 2004.
