The Secretary of State, being the designated ^{M1} Minister for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 ^{M2} in relation to measures relating to the prevention and limitation of the effects of accidents involving dangerous substances, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the said section 2(2) and by sections 15(1) and (2) and 82(3)(a) of, and paragraphs 1(1) and (2), 15(1) and 16 of Schedule 3 to, the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 ^{M3} (“the Act”) and for the purpose of giving effect without modifications to proposals submitted to him by the Health and Safety Commission under section 11(2)(d) of the Act after the carrying out by the Commission of consultations in accordance with section 50(2) of the Act, hereby makes the following Regulations—
