# The Passenger and Goods Vehicles (Recording Equipment) (Tachograph Card Fees) Regulations 2005

### Replacement cards

- 7. If the holder of a tachograph card—
  - (a) satisfies the Secretary of State that
    - (i) the card is damaged, malfunctions, is lost or is stolen; and
    - (ii) the holder is entitled to continue to hold the card;
  - (b) surrenders the damaged or malfunctioning card to the Secretary of State;
  - (c) applies to the Secretary of State within seven days of such damage, malfunction, loss or theft;
  - (d) makes his application in such form, and provides the Secretary of State with such documents and information in support of the application, as the Secretary of State may require; and
- (e) pays the fee prescribed in accordance with regulation 8 for the replacement of a card, the Secretary of State shall issue a replacement card.
