The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by section 15 of the Social Security Act 1990 ^{MI}, and with the consent of the Treasury, makes the following Regulations:

As regards Wales, those functions are exercisable by the National Assembly for Wales concurrently with the Secretary of State; see the reference to the Social Security Act 1990 in Schedule 1 to the [National Assembly for Wales \(Transfer of Functions\) Order 1999 \(S.I. 1999/672\)](#).
