The End-of-Life Vehicles (Producer Responsibility) Regulations 2005

Offences

- 23. A producer who fails to comply with any or all of the requirements of regulations
 - (a) 7 (1), (2), (3), (4) or (9);
 - (b) 10 (1) to (6);
 - (c) 11; and
 - (d) 12

shall be guilty of an offence.

- (2) A person who fails to comply with regulation 18 shall be guilty of an offence.
- (3) A person who
 - (a) fails to submit a certificate of compliance in accordance with regulation 19;
 - (b) furnishes a certificate of compliance under regulation 19 and either
 - (i) knows the information provided in or in connection with the certificate to be false or misleading in a material particular; or
 - (ii) furnishes such information recklessly and it is false or misleading in a material particular;
 - (c) fails without reasonable excuse to furnish any information required by the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 19(3); or
 - (d) furnishes any information required by the Secretary of State in connection with her functions, powers and duties under these Regulations and either—
 - (i) knows the information to be false or misleading in a material particular; or
 - (ii) furnishes such information recklessly and it is false or misleading in a material particular;

shall be guilty of an offence.

(4) Any person who intentionally delays or obstructs a person authorised by the Secretary of State in the exercise of the powers referred to in these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence.
