**PENSIONS**

**The Pension Protection Fund (Partially Guaranteed Schemes) (Modification) Regulations 2005**

*Made - - - - 10th February 2005*  
*Laid before Parliament 15th February 2005*  
*Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1(1)*

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 307(3), 315(5) and 318(1) of the Pensions Act 2004 <sup>M1</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, by this instrument, which is made before the end of the period of six months beginning with the coming into force of the provisions of that Act by virtue of which it is made <sup>M2</sup>, makes the following Regulations:

**Marginal Citations**

- M1** 2004 c. 35. Section 318(1) is cited because of the meaning there given to “modifications”, “prescribed” and “regulations”.
- M2** See section 317 of the Pensions Act 2004 (“the Act”) which provides that the Secretary of State must consult such persons as he considers appropriate before making regulations by virtue of the provisions of that Act (other than Part 8). This duty does not apply where regulations are made before the end of the period of six months beginning with the coming into force of the provisions of that Act by virtue of which the regulations are made.
