### [F1Conditions: introductory

- **3.** Subject to the provisions of any scheme made by the Secretary of State under section 300 (transfer schemes) and any order made under section 303 (power to make consequential provision) of the 2012 Act, [F2NHS England] may only enter into a contract if the conditions set out in—
  - (a) regulation 4; and
  - (b) in the case of a contract to be entered into with a dental corporation on or after the coming into force for all purposes of article 39 of the Dentists Act Order (substitution of sections 43 and 44), regulation 5,

are met.]
