Tuberculosis test records

- **10.**—(1) Where a skin test has been applied to a bovine animal, the Secretary of State shall, as soon as practicable after the results of the test have been read by an inspector, give the keeper of that animal a record in writing of the results of the test.
- (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to animals in respect of which movement is, or remains prohibited under this Order following the test.
 - (3) The keeper of any animal to which paragraph (1) applies shall—
 - (a) retain the record of the results of the test for a period of 3 years and 60 days following the date of injection of tuberculin; and
 - (b) produce such record when requested to do so by an inspector.
