The National Health Service (Dental Charges) Regulations 2005

Made - - - - - *19th December 2005*

Coming into force - - - - - *1st April 2006*

The Secretary of State for Health makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by sections 79, 83A and 126(4) of, and Schedule 12ZA to, the National Health Service Act 1977⁽¹⁾;
