The National Health Service (Dental Charges) Regulations 2005

[^{F1}Reduction of remuneration and accounting for charges in relation to providers of relevant primary dental services

12. Where a provider of relevant primary dental services has provided relevant primary dental services for which a charge is payable under these Regulations, the remuneration which would otherwise be payable by [^{F2}NHS England] to that provider shall be reduced by the amount of that charge, irrespective of whether or not that charge has been recovered by the provider.]
