PREVENTION AND SUPPRESSION OF TERRORISM

The Terrorism Act 2000 (Continuance of Part VII) Order 2005

Made - - - - 15th February 2005

Coming into force - - 19th February 2005

Whereas a draft of this Order has been laid before Parliament under section 123(4)(f) of the Terrorism Act 2000(a), and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 112(2)(a) and (b) of the Terrorism Act 2000, the Secretary of State hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Terrorism Act 2000 (Continuance of Part VII) Order 2005 and shall come into force on 19th February 2005.
- **2.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the provisions of Part VII of the Terrorism Act 2000 which are in force on 18th February 2005(**b**) shall continue in force for the period beginning 19th February 2005 and ending with 18th February 2006.
 - (2) The following provisions of the Terrorism Act 2000 shall cease to have effect:—
 - (a) Section 67(3) and (4);
 - (b) Section 70; and
 - (c) Section 71.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order continues in force for a further period of twelve months the provisions of Part VII of the Terrorism Act 2000 (which extend to Northern Ireland only) with the exception of the following provisions:

- (a) section 100, which has not been brought into force;
- (b) sections 67(3) and (4), 70 and 71, which by virtue of this Order shall cease to have effect on 19th February 2005;
- (c) section 76(a);
- (d) section 97(1) and (2)(b);
- (e) section $97(3)(\mathbf{c})$;
- (f) paragraph 36 of Schedule 4(d);
- (g) paragraph 19 to 21 of Schedule 5(e).

The provisions continued in force by this Order will continue in force up to and including 18th February 2006.
