PART 7

COMMENCING PROCEEDINGS IN MAGISTRATES' COURTS

Information and complaint

- 7.1.—(1) An information may be laid or complaint made by the prosecutor or complainant in person or by his counsel or solicitor or other person authorised in that behalf.
- (2) Subject to any provision of the Magistrates' Courts Act 1980(1) and any other enactment, an information or complaint need not be in writing or on oath.
